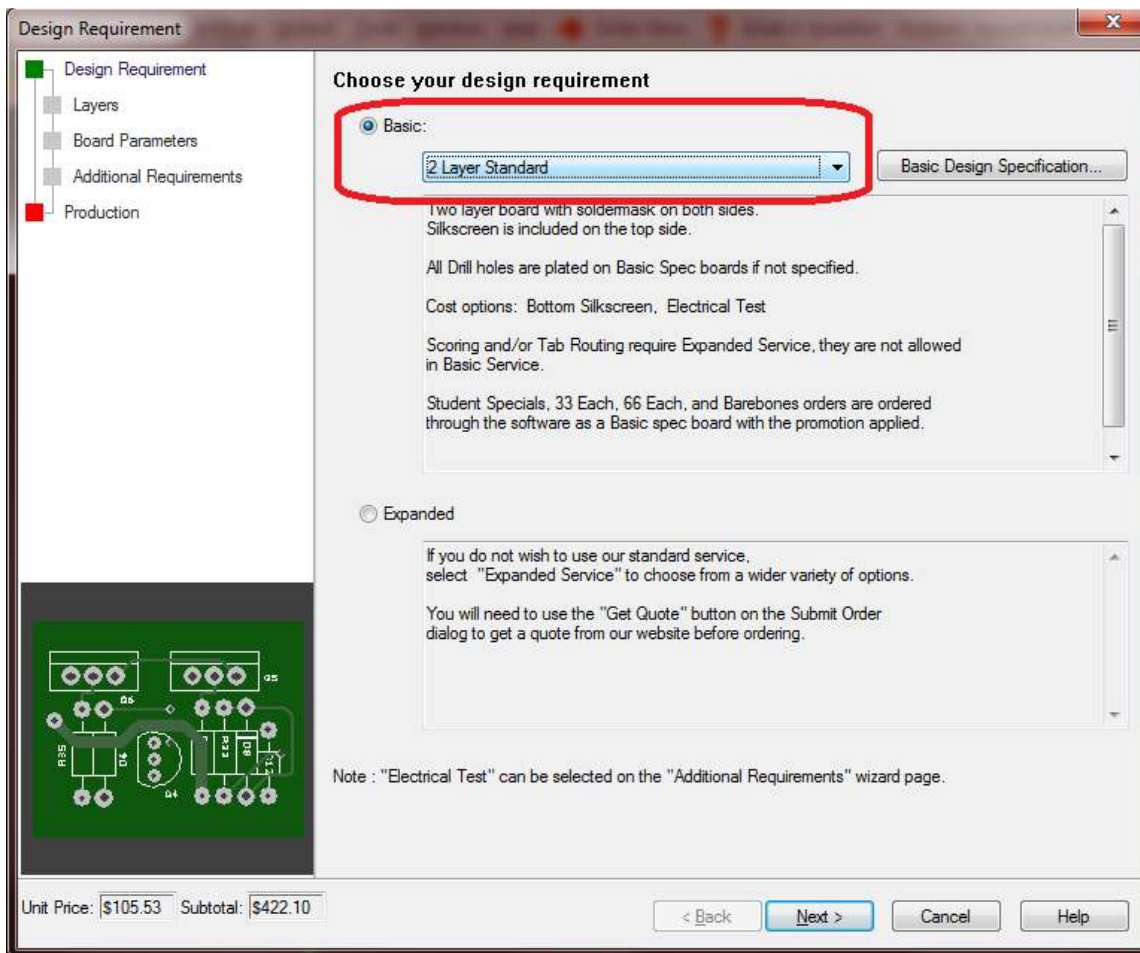
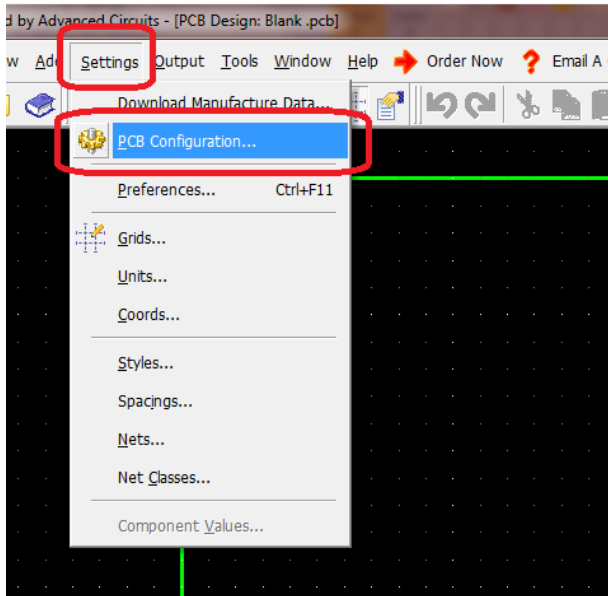


33Each and 66Each In PCB Artist™

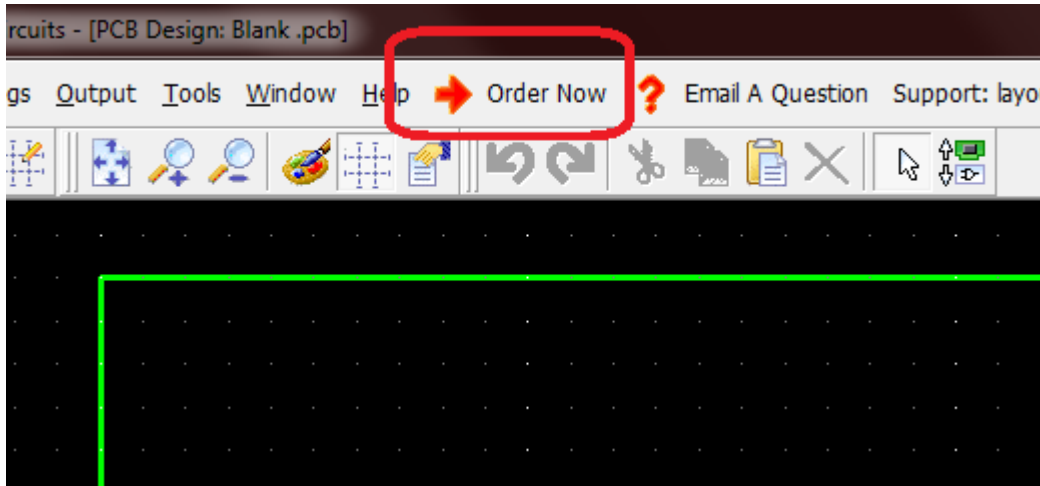
Ordering 33Each or 66Each in PCB Artist™ requires the customer to order through the PCB Artist™ software. First make sure your board design is in “Basic Spec”. Go to Settings > PCB Configuration to check.



The PCB Configuration is also where one can set up the board order. Make sure your order matches the 33Each or 66Each specs found here: <https://www.4pcb.com/pcb-prototype-2-4-layer-boards-specials.html>

Click Finish on the production section to save the changes in the PCB Configuration.

To order, click the Order Now link at the top of the software:

In the promotion section, put 33each or 66each (depending on the order type):
